Apprentices are the key to sustaining and advancing the Painting and Decorating industry in the future, which is why we need to foster and reward their achievements now. The apprentices that do good work, need to be recognised and celebrated for that.

Entry Fees

There is no cost to enter a nomination for the Apprentice of the Year award.

Notes for Entrants

For practical reasons, assessment of entries will be carried out based on information supplied on the entry form. Short listed apprentices will be presented to the panel and may be visited by the panel to verify suitability for the Award. Apprentice chances are restricted when entries are not supported by sufficient material. Entries will not be returned.

Assessment Procedure

Forms must be completed by the party who is nominating the apprentice, plus further documentation if required.

Submission Documents

In addition to a completed nomination form, each submission must include a document that covers the below in relation to the nominated apprentice:

- Brief history of the apprentice and year completed
- Achievements
- Skills
- Communication
- General Appearance
- Ability to work with others
 References from teachers and employers

Judging Panel

Generally consist of 3 persons.

Judges should have the purpose of illustrating and defining the standards used for judging to the members of the public.
